Re-registration for 2023-2024!

Spots are filling up fast! To reserve your space for your student, be sure to complete the application and return it with your full registration. Your student will not be enrolled without an application and full registration (or \$100 deposit per student, with the remainder of the registration due by July 1). If you prefer, go through the reenrollment process on RenWeb to ensure we have accurate information on you and your student. You may not be able to do this on your phone and may need to use a computer.

1. Log in to RenWeb. The District Code is HCHC-CA. On the left side of the screen, click on "Family Information." Then click on "Enrollment/Reenrollment."
2. On the right side of the screen, choose the student (or students) you wish to reenroll.
3. Review the form and make any necessary changes.
4. Click on the "Next" button.
5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 for all forms.
6. On the last page, click "Finish."
(Remember, you may make your payment via cash, check, or Venmo.)
